## 2 pronouncement


authoritarian one-way message inequality of power no intention of exchange "I know what is best"

### 3 polemic

"argument is war" (Lakoff) i.e. Crossfire lack of listening e aggression sparring use of intimidation efforts to discredit 'opponent', sometimes by any means, whether true or false one version of the truth


# 4 debate

implies fixed positions making arguments, point by point winners and losers right or wrong reasoned, logical efforts at "winning" one is chosen legalistic (courtrooms, judgments, punishments) lack of ambiguity



# 5 discussion

civil discourse give and take negotiation problem-solving efforts at persuasion conciliation consensus examination and "breaking apart" of issue seeing its elements



# 6 dialogue

appreciation of common ground requires conditions of trust based on listening equality potential for discovery insight expanded understanding entering the unknown place beyond "positions" erotic, like a dance exploration play innovation creativity
